

How To Use Self-Paced Mode

There are two types of polling or testing scenarios. In the first, your instructor will ask a Question, you and your classmates will send your answers to the Question, and, after the Timer expires, a Response Chart will display showing a graph of the distribution of the answers to the Question. This process is repeated for each Question polled during the Session.

The second scenario is called *Self Paced*. At the beginning of a typical Self Paced Session, you will be given a printout of all the Questions and Response Choices, if applicable. In this testing scenario, the entire Session is timed, rather than each Question. You can work at your own pace and answer the Questions in any order.

Using Your Clicker in Self Paced Mode

Power on your Clicker and press the Quick Jump key to join the Class as you normally would. The difference is that when your instructor started this Class, he or she started it in *Self Paced Mode*. This information is transmitted to your Clicker when the Class was joined, so it is automatically set up to participate in a Self Paced Session.

- Enter a **TST** number, if instructed to do so. Use the Down Scroll key to go to the first Question Response field. Both of the Scroll keys can be used to navigate from Response field to Response field.
- Use the *Input Keys* on your Clicker keypad to compose each of your Responses to the Questions.
- Press the Enter/Send key to send each Response.

Your instructor has the option of limiting the number of times you can answer a specific Question, or of allowing you to answer a Question as many times as you want within the time frame of the Session. In either case, each time you answer a Question, press the Enter/Send key to send it to the PRS software, which records and stores it. The second line of your LCD display will keep you informed of the status of your transmissions.

Note:

When the Countdown Timer expires, the Self Paced Session is over and Clicker transmissions will no longer be accepted.

Don't turn off your Clicker during a Self Paced Session until you have finished the test. When you turn off your Clicker, you are no longer joined to the Class and you cannot continue to participate in the Session unless you rejoin it.
