3. GTCO Calcomp introduces interactive wireless tablets

The MeetingPad 400 and SchoolPad 400 are 6 x 8-inch tablets capable of wirelessly interacting with computer applications from up to 300 feet away. The pads include a USB Bluetooth wireless technology hub and can be used in conjunction with one of GTCO Calcomp's interactive whiteboards. They can also be used to annotate over projected contents via a computer/projector connection. New features for the tablets include a 40-hour battery life, a rechargeable pen, and InterWrite software that allows annotation over electronic presentations and other applications. The MeetingPad 400 will cost \$585; the SchoolPad 400, \$497. Both will be available April 1.
