This new version of *InterWrite PRS Software* works cross-platform, giving educators the option to use a PC or Mac operating system to create and deliver questions using PowerPoint, while students can use it to take in-class assessments in a non-timed, self-paced mode. The software solution has also added new reports and enhanced its charting capabilities to allow educators to view results in 3-D and pie charts. Price is \$1,466 for 32 transmitters, one receiver, and the *InterWrite PRS Software*.
